- ADB's Strategy 2020: focus on inclusive growth
- 2009 Energy Policy:
 - access to energy one of three pillars for ADB's support to the energy sector
 - annual investment of \$2 billion on clean energy from 2013
- Energy for All Initiative

Energy for All Initiative

- Develops scalable and replicable approaches for extending access to modern energy
- Mainstream access to energy in ADB's operations through:
 - Project identification, design and development
 - Knowledge management
- Supports the Energy for All Partnership



Energy for All Partnership

What: Regional, multi-stakeholder platform for networking, cooperation, sharing lessons learned, developing “scaling up” projects

Objective: Provide access to reliable and affordable modern energy services to 100 million people in Asia and the Pacific by 2015

Why: Responds to stakeholders’ call for a regional platform to overcome the challenges of scaling up successful models

Who: Brings together key stakeholders from private sector, financial institutions, governments, NGOs. Secretariat at ADB facilitated by FDC.

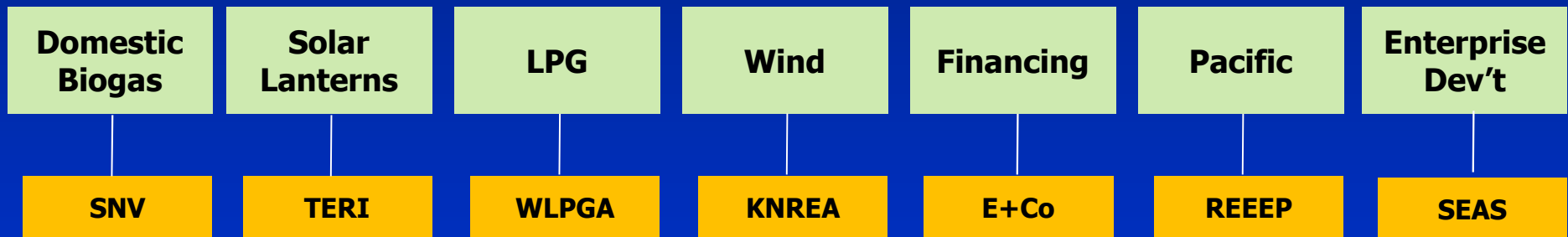
How: Seed funding provided by ADB for secretariat and working group activities

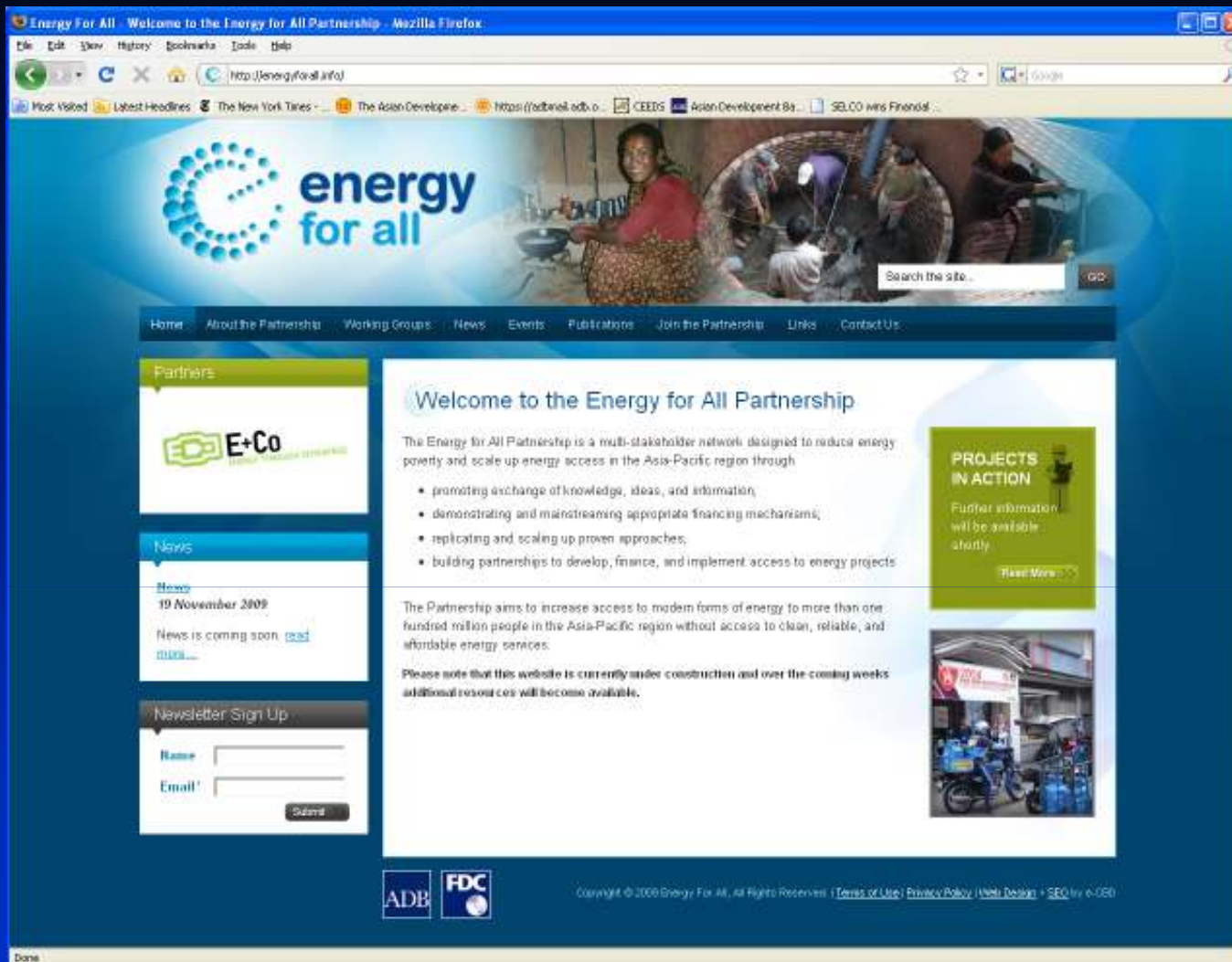

Working Groups

- Bring together key stakeholders active on a particular technology/issue/region
- Objective: project development
- 7 working groups established
 - Technologies: solar lanterns, biogas, LPG, wind
 - Themes: energy enterprise development, financing
 - Geographic: Pacific region
 - 8th WG on small hydro planned
- Secretariat support provided to develop work plans, coordinate with other WGs, carry out activities

Working Group Activities

- Activities in 2009:
 - Workshop on expanding use of LPG in Timor-Leste
 - International workshop on domestic biogas
 - Feasibility study for national biogas program in Philippines
 - Scoping studies on scaling up use of solar lanterns in Cambodia, Indonesia, PNG
 - Market opening seminar for financial institutions in Cambodia
- Target activities in 2010
 - Establishing revolving funds to finance energy access projects (Cambodia, Pacific)
 - Projects providing access to energy to at least 2.5 million people by mid-2010
 - Establishing at least one new sustainable energy association

Working Group on Wind Power: Proposed objective and targets

- Objectives:
 - technology transfer
 - reduction in manufacturing costs
 - project implementation
- Interim targets:
 - Pilot project implementation (6 by 2012?)
 - Transfer of small-wind technologies
- Long-term targets:
 - At least 2.5m people served with distributed wind power by 2020
 - Cost/kW of small-scale wind reduced by 50% by 2020

WG on Wind Power: Activities

- Proposed Activities:
 - Technical evaluation and feasibility studies
 - Technology transfer and manufacturing optimization
 - Financing and implementation arrangements
 - Capacity building: wind resource assessment, local manufacturing
 - Project implementation
 - **Others?**
